LINKAGES

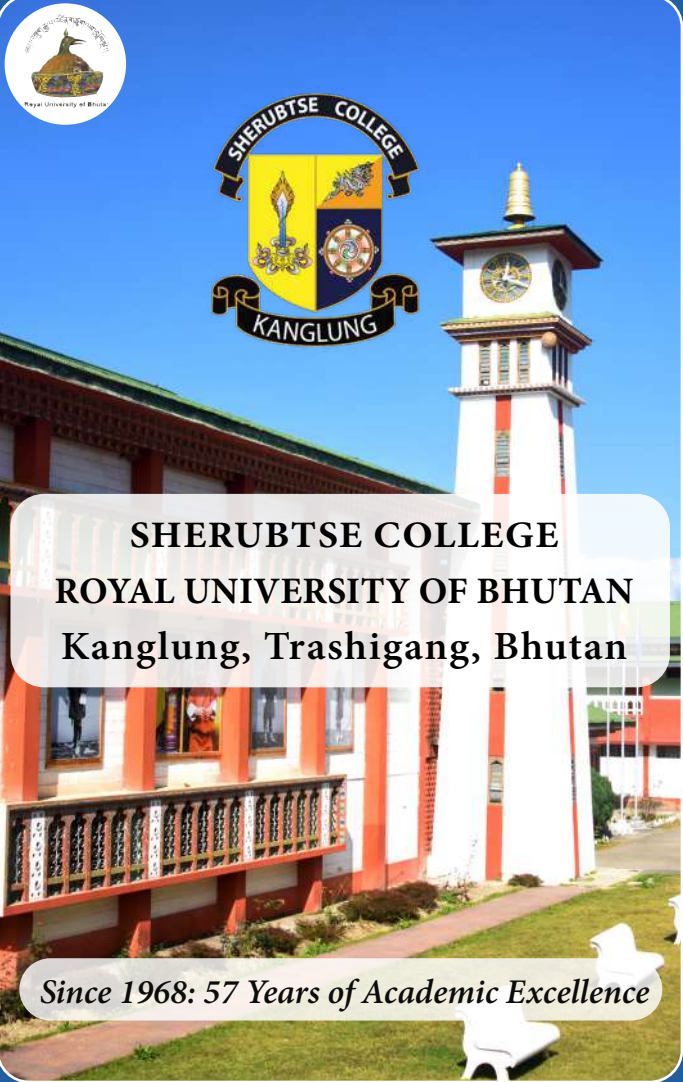

SHERUBTSE COLLEGE PROFILE

After opening up to the outside world in the late fifties of the twentieth century, the third Druk Gyalpo of Bhutan His Majesty Jigme Dorji Wangchuk – aspired to secure a role in the global community for the young citizens of His Kingdom. Realizing that education is the vital catalyst for the socio-economic development of a country - He wanted the students in Bhutan to catch-up with the scientific and technological developments in other parts of the world. His desire was finally given a shape by the establishment of first ever English medium public school at Kanglung in 1968. His Majesty the third Druk Gyalpo inaugurated his dream school on the 26th of May 1968 and named it Sherubtse – the peak of learning – with the motto “Education for Excellence”. Since then, Sherubtse College has been growing to become the most popular institute of higher learning in Bhutan.
